Greo Funding Disclosure

Greo's funding for the **Prevention and Education Review: Gambling-Related Harm** is derived from regulatory settlements in lieu of financial penalties from operators in Great Britain. The Commission reviews and approves proposals for destinations of regulatory settlements. Under the terms of a settlement, there is to be no publicity or benefit for the operator in connection with the regulatory settlement.

The monies represent a restricted payment to Greo to accelerate progress towards delivery of the National Strategy to Reduce Gambling Harms in Great Britain. The **Prevention and Education Review: Gambling-Related Harm** has been conducted with the support of an Advisory Committee with a mandate to provide guidance and oversight to strengthen the quality and defensibility of the review, and to support mobilisation and uptake of the review findings. The Advisory Committee comprises representatives from the Gambling Commission, Public Health England, Advisory Board for Safer Gambling, and University of Massachusetts.
